

Security/Access to Buildings

Security for BOCES buildings and grounds contributes to the well being and safety of staff as well as to that of the sites themselves.

An adequate key control system shall be established which shall limit access to buildings to authorized BOCES personnel and shall safeguard against entrance to buildings by persons unauthorized to have keys.

"Security" means not only keeping buildings locked and secure but also providing protection against physical hazards and acts of violence. It also includes having available floor plans of buildings and site plans showing site boundaries and access points. The Board requires and encourages close cooperation with local police, fire and sheriff's departments and insurance company inspectors.

Alarm systems and other devices that protect buildings against illegal entry and vandalism shall be installed where appropriate.
